Hopper Installation

(Fig. 39)



If the conveyor is equipped with a standard hopper and is shipped with hopper not installed, the hopper will need to be bolted on. (Fig. 39)

Mounting holes for the hopper are usually predrilled in the rails at the factory. Simply line the holes in the hopper up with holes in the rails and bolt them into place by using ¼" bolts supplied. If the rails are not pre-drilled and the hopper needs to be installed, line the back bottom edge of the hopper up with the ¼" rod on the end flapper and mark holes on the rails. Remove the hopper and drill holes for ¼" bolts. Install the hopper after all holes have been drilled. (Fig. 40)

NOTE: Back bottom edge of the hopper should line up with the ¼" rod on the end flapper. (Fig. 41) This will keep the gap between the hopper and end flapper to a minimum.
